Our services are provided to all families who have lost a child up to the age of 12 years. All our services are provided nationwide and are free of charge.

This service is confidential, and is available seven days a week.

Befriending Service

The befriending service is on offer to bereaved parents. Befrienders are parents who have attended bereavement groups and following this have been trained in basic listening and befriending skills.

Home Visits

Home visits are provided to newly bereaved parents. The aim of this visit is to provide parents with the opportunity to ask questions, talk about their child, and about the grieving process in the privacy and comfort of their own home. Parents are encouraged to talk through our services and discuss what their own individual needs may be.

Crisis Intervention

When FirstLight is notified of the death of a child on our hot-line 087–2423777 and if the parents consent, our support services coordinator contacts the parents.

If this contact is at the time of the death of the child our coordinator will talk the parents through the following days step by step.

The purpose of this is to encourage them to make decisions about their child. They couldn't control the death of their child but they can control what happens in the following days.

This service is available 7 days a week.

Individual Counselling and Psychotherapy

Everyone is different and each person's need is different, especially so in grief. Counselling and psychotherapy can be helpful to talk through feelings and thoughts that may be difficult to share with family and friends. FirstLight has a database of therapists throughout the country. This service is provided free of charge and all therapists are fully qualified.

Couple Counselling and Psychotherapy

Distress may be caused by growing conflict, poor communication, difficulty with acknowledging and expressing feelings or a range of other factors. No two people grieve the same, but because of that some or all of the above factors may become obvious in the relationship. This type of therapy can help couples come together to discuss their feelings and thoughts.

Residential Groups

The residential groups involve parents committing to a structured programme which involves parents committing to attend one Friday night and Saturday once a month for four months.

It is structured in a way that allows parents to explore their grief and how they are coping with it. Mothers and Fathers grief is totally different ways, the weekends acknowledge this and have time out time from partners to openly explore their own grief.

Groups are facilitated by qualified psychotherapist.
